



## WPFC Notice Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19

*Your family's health and well-being are very important to us. Due to the current concerns regarding the COVID-19 pandemic and the risk that engaging in a group activity such as soccer presents to each family, Woodland Park Futbol Club (WPFC) wants to inform all our participants of the following:*

COVID-19 has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization (WHO) and is extremely contagious. The state of medical knowledge is evolving, but the virus is believed to spread from person-to-person contact and/or by contact with contaminated surfaces and objects, and even possibly in the air. People reportedly can be infected and show no symptoms and therefore spread the disease. The exact methods of spread and contraction are unknown, and there is no known treatment, cure, or vaccine for COVID-19 at this time. Evidence has shown that COVID-19 can cause serious and potentially life-threatening illness and even death.

**Although WPFC will be implementing preventative measures including adhering to CDC, state, and local health guidelines, to reduce the spread of COVID-19, we ask you to understand that we cannot guarantee that club activities are COVID-19 free or prevent players or their families from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 while participating in our program.** Therefore, if you voluntarily choose to allow your player to participate with WPFC and/or your family to be present at WPFC activities, individuals may be exposed to and/or increasing the risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19.

WPFC and its coaches recognize and will make our best effort to reduce the risk of spreading the COVID-19 virus. Practices will include awareness of current health guidelines, proper organization, supervision, instruction, and equipment care/sanitation, in addition to awareness of social distancing and other precautions communicated through the coaches to your players. It is impossible to guarantee absolute safety from infection; therefore we ask you to understand that you share and assume the responsibility for safety during all activities. We need and expect you to make the coaches aware of any potential exposure risks prior to participation, and to make your best effort to ensure the health of your player and family before participating in any soccer activity.

**Do not attend WPFC activities if anyone in your family is experiencing any symptoms of illness such as fever, cough, shortness of breath, flu-like symptoms, headache, or new loss of taste/smell. Please immediately advise your coach if any of the following apply to your player or family:**

- Been exposed in the last 14 days to a person with a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19
- Been diagnosed with COVID-19 and not yet cleared as non-contagious by a qualified medical provider or according to isolation/quarantine guidelines (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/if-you-are-sick/quarantine.html>)
- Traveled outside the United States within the past 14 days

*By continuing with WPFC, you are indicating that you have read and understood the above notice concerning COVID-19, and voluntarily agree that WPFC soccer is of such value to you that you accept the risk of being exposed to, contracting, and/or spreading COVID-19 in order for your player to participate in our program. You also acknowledge that you are under obligation to report symptoms and avoid participating in any activities if you, your player, and any family members or guests may be contagious or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19. You agree to hold harmless WPFC and any of its volunteers with respect to any and all illness, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, to the fullest extent permitted by law.*
